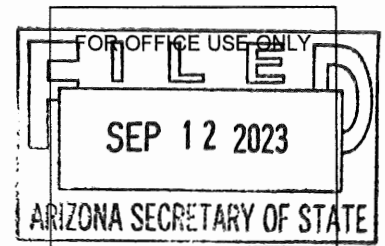

In order to promote the People of the State of Arizona's economic security, freedom of association, freedom of speech, and the freedom to interact and organize to express, pursue and defend collectively their common interests, such rights being guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States of America, this act, known as the "ARIZONA WORKS TOGETHER ACT" proposes to repeal Article XXV of the Constitution of Arizona relating to the "Right To Work" as follows: "Article XXV of the Constitution of Arizona, relating to the right to work, is repealed."

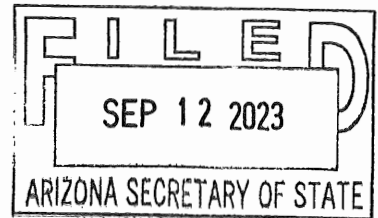

A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

REPEALING ARTICLE XXV OF THE ARIZONA CONSTITUTION, RELATING TO THE RIGHT TO WORK.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Arizona:

**SECTION 1: Short Title**

This constitutional amendment shall be known as, and may be referred to as, the “Arizona Works Together Act.”

**SECTION 2: Findings and declaration of purpose**

The People of the State of Arizona find and declare as follows:

- A. The People of the State of Arizona desire to promote economic security, freedom of association, freedom of speech, and freedom to interact and organize to express, pursue, and defend their common interests through collective action.
- B. The Arizona Constitution must be amended to repeal any provisions that establish the so-called “Right to Work”.

**SECTION 3: Repeal of Article XXV of the Constitution of Arizona**

Article XXV of the Constitution of Arizona, relating to the Right to Work, is repealed.

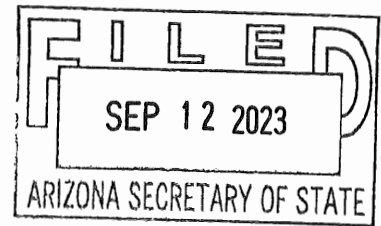
~~No person shall be denied the opportunity to obtain or retain employment because of non membership in a labor organization, nor shall the State or any subdivision thereof, or any corporation, individual or association of any kind enter into any agreement, written or oral, which excludes any person from employment or continuation of employment because of non membership in a labor organization.~~

**SECTION 4: No new taxes**

This constitutional amendment shall not be interpreted as to create or as to require the creation or collection of any new taxes not currently set forth under established law.

**SECTION 5: Severability**

If a provision of this measure or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the act that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.



**SECTION 6:** Submission to the electorate

The Secretary of State shall submit this measure to the qualified electors of the State of Arizona at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1, section 1, Arizona Constitution.

**SECTION 7:** Standing and legal defense

The People of the State of Arizona desire that this initiative, if approved by the voters, be defended if it is challenged in court. The People of the State of Arizona therefore declare that the political committee registered to circulate petitions and campaign in support of the adoption of the initiative (or its designee) shall have standing to initiate or intervene in any action or proceeding to defend this measure on behalf of and as the agent of the People of Arizona.
